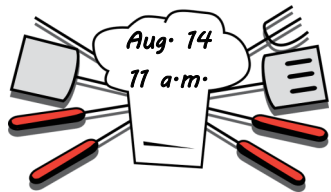

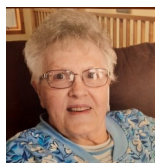
With Sympathy and Prayers
